POTTSGROVE'S STEVE AMBS

STEVE AMBS, POTTSGROVE

Defensive End ... Senior ... 6-2, 210 ... Credited with 49 tackles ... Had team-high 7.5 sacks ... On offense, help anchor offensive line at tight end and caught six passes for 71 yards and four touchdowns for the District 1-AAA champions ... All PAC-10 selection.

TOM BODOLUS, DANIEL BOONE

Defensive Back ... Senior ... 6-1, 195 ... Ran 241 times for 1,352 yards and 19 touchdowns ... Completed 140 of 223 attempts for 1,775 yards and 19 touchdowns ... Led area with 3,127 yards of total offense ... On defense, credited with 101 tackles, including one sack ... Intercepted one pass, forced two fumbles and recovered one ... All-Berks selection ... BFL Section One's Offensive and Defensive Back of the Year ... The Mercury's Player of the Year.

ERIC BONENBERGER, POTTSGROVE

Offensive Guard ... Senior ... 6-3, 250 ... A three-year starter, helped anchor offensive line that led the area in rushing (327 yards a game) and total offense (374 yards a game) ... Key in team's drive to the District 1-AAA championship ... All PAC-10 selection.

DAVID COTELLESE, POPE JOHN PAUL II

Quarterback ... Senior ... 6-0, 180 ... Led the area in completions (159), attempts (307), yards (2,200), and touchdown passes (23) ... Had six games of 200 yards or more, tied the PAC-10 record for touchdown passes in a game (five), and threw at least one touchdown pass in all but one game ... Offensive key in team's drive to a .500 regular-season mark and berth in the District 1-AAA playoffs in school's second season ... All PAC-10 selection. ... The Mercury's Offensive Player of the Year.

ROBBIE CURTIN, POTTSGROVE

Linebacker ... Senior ... 5-9, 195 ... Credited with 87 tackles, solidifying defense that was second in the area in yards allowed rushing and yards allowed overall ... On offense, carried 119 times for 960 yards and 14 touchdowns, more than half of those totals coming over the final five games to help his team to the District 1-AAA championship ... All PAC-10 selection.

BRIAN CZOP, SPRING-FORD

Center ... Senior ... 5-10, 220 ... Anchored line that produced the area's No. 1 offense, and a very balanced one - averaging 189 yards rushing, 186 passing and 375 overall ... Leader in team's drive to the PAC-10 championship and first postseason appearance ... All PAC-10 selection.

RON GILLESPIE, UPPER PERKIOMEN

Wide Receiver ... Senior ... 5-10, 165 ... Tied for second in the area in receptions with 52 for 790 yards and five touchdowns ... Finished as area's all-time career leader in receiving yardage (2,147), is third all-time with 113 career catches ... Will attend Temple on football scholarship ... All PAC-10 selection.

JACOB GRIBB, POPE JOHN PAUL II

Wide Receiver ... Senior ... 6-3, 205 ... Caught 41 passes for 657 yards and six touchdowns ... On defense, credited with 43 tackles, including a team-high three sacks, splitting time at end and outside linebacker ... Two-way starter helped team's drive to a .500 regular-season mark and berth in the District 1-AAA playoffs in school's second season ... All PAC-10 selection.

TORY HUDGINS, POTTSGROVE

Quarterback ... Junior ... 6-0, 175 ... Led the area in rushing (211 carries, 1,530 yards) and scoring (27 touchdowns, 164 points) guiding the team's offense ... Completed 35 of 60 passes for 655 yards, with just one interception and 10 touchdowns - a 201.7 passing rating - in helping his team to the District 1-AAA championship ... All PAC-10 selection.

CORY HUEBER, POTTSTOWN

Linebacker ... Senior ... 6-3, 190 ... Credited with a team-high 135 tackles, including 90 solo - both of which led the entire area ... Had two sacks ... Forced a fumble and recovered one ... On offense, anchored team's line at left guard ... All PAC-10 selection.

TIM HUNT, PHOENIXVILLE

Offensive Tackle ... Senior ... 5-11, 275 ... Touted as team's best offensive lineman, helping Phantoms to 325 yards of a game ... Played in final two games despite severe knee injury ... Also in on 20 tackles and had one fumble recovery on defense ... Key in team's drive to the District 1-AAA final ... All PAC-10 selection.

RYAN IGNATOVIG, POPE JOHN PAUL II

Defensive Interior Lineman ... Senior ... 6-4, 245 ... Considered team's best lineman, finishing with 76 tackles ... Key two-way starter in team's drive to a .500 regular-season mark and berth in the District 1-AAA playoffs in school's second season ... All PAC-10 selection.

JARRED JONES, SPRING-FORD

Running Back ... Sophomore ... 5-10, 180 ... Second in the area in rushing, carrying 165 times for 1,520 yards and 20 touchdowns ... His 9.2 yards per carry led all area ballcarriers ... Ran for 100 or more yards in eight games, helping his team to the PAC-10 championship and first postseason appearance ... All PAC-10 selection.

DENNIS KELLY, PHOENIXVILLE

Defensive End ... Senior ... 5-10, 185 ... Credited with 81 tackles ... Had team-high five sacks ... Forced two fumbles and recovered another ... One of defensive keys in team's drive to the District 1-AAA final ... All PAC-10 selection.

ERNIE KNIGHT, PHOENIXVILLE

Defensive Interior Lineman ... Senior ... 6-1, 250 ... Credited with 65 tackles ... Had one sack ... One of defensive keys in team's drive to the District 1-AAA final ... All PAC-10 selection.

NICK LAPERCHE, METHACTON

Punter ... Senior ... 5-11, 205 ... Averaged an area-high 38.8 yards on 37 punts ... Also converted 28 point-afters and five field goals for 43 kick-scoring points ... Arguably the area's strongest leg ... All PAC-10 selection.
